If the bioinformatics personnel contribute with their scientific knowledge to solve the scientific questions, they should be co-authors according to the “*ICMJE Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals concerning Authorship and Contributor ship*” (Vancouver rules).
